Launch 2 new programs to help expand the economy of the Northwest Illinois region. (Ongoing -1 program launched)

In 2021, the Genz Memorial Investment Fund was launched to serve as a gap tool for businesses and entrepreneurs in Carroll and Jo Daviess Counties. The principal of the fund is over \$400,000, and annually 3-4 awards can be given out ranging between \$4,000 - \$8,000.

# SUPPORTING PARTNER INITIATIVES

### LRA INTERMODAL PORT DEVELOPMENT

The Local Redevelopment Authority (LRA), in tandem with the Upper Mississippi River International Port District, presented the U.S. Army a reuse plan for their Parcel 20 site for a proposed intermodal port at the confluence of the Apple River and the Mississippi River at the Savanna Industrial Park (former Army Depot). Early projections for the new port:



- Buildout Cost = \$45-65 million
- Jobs Created = 1,400 to 1,700
- Economic Development Impact = \$70 to \$150 million

### JO DAVIESS COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING

NWILED is embarking on a strategic planning process for the revision of the Jo Daviess County Comprehensive Plan, which was first adopted in 2012. Once completed, the plan will guide decisionmakers for the next 20+ years.



### INTERSECT ILLINOIS PROJECT REVIEWS

Since October 2022, NWILED has fielded over 36 Intersect Illinois project requests for both Carroll and Jo Daviess Counties resulting in 1 project response.

Note NWILED hosted Dan Seals, CEO @ Intersect, at our 2022 annual meeting, which gathered over 125 guests from 35 different organizations. Mr. Seals delivered the keynote address.



### JO DAVIESS COUNTY REVOLVING LOAN FUND

NWILED is the first point of contact for the JDC Revolving Loan. NWILED reviews applications prior to advancing them to the JDC Board. Since 2022, NWILED has worked on 2 projects.



## **NWILED BEHIND THE SCENES**

- Advocating for the re-establishment of passenger rail service from Rockford to Dubuque with a proposed station in Galena, flag stop in Warren, and emergency stop in East Dubuque.
- Awarded the 2023 NWILED John D. Cooke Memorial Entrepreneurial Scholarship distributing \$6,000 to high school students in Carroll and Jo Daviess Counties that are entrepreneurial, want to start a business or peruse a career in business, and who intend to maintain strong relationships with the Northwest Illinois region.
- Hosted the Illinois Finance Authority to highlight their new Commercial Property Assessed Clean Energy ("C-PACE") financing program to help accelerate private investment in green energy projects (solar, double-pained windows, smart roofs, LED lighting).
- Maintaining the NWILED online site map, which details industrial sites and commercial storefronts that are for sale in Carroll and Jo Daviess Counties and feeds into the Intersect Illinois business recruitment system. Currently, 30 buildings and 12 vacant sites are live on the NWILED website.
- Drove regional awareness of the State of Illinois Back to Business grants for hotels, restaurants, and creative arts program announced winter/spring 2023.
  - Note NWILED served as a Community Navigator Spoke for the 2022 B2B program, which resulted in \$690,000+ being awarded in Carroll and Jo Daviess Counties.

## **NWILED LOOKING AHEAD**

### **BUILD IT - GROW IT**

In 2021 NWILED wrapped the Build It - Grow It program, a multiyear commitment that provided "Business 101" workshops throughout Carroll, Jo Daviess, and Whiteside Counties. Planning is in the works to revamp the program for a relaunch in 2024 with workshops tentatively scheduled in Galena and Savanna.

### CARROLL COUNTY OUTREACH

Monthly NWILED satellite office hours began at the Carroll County Courthouse in Mount Carroll April 2023. This expanded local presence will help advance NWILED's reputation in the County, build new professional relationships, and lead to new business starts and expansions.

### JO DAVIESS COUNTY OUTREACH

NWILED accepted an invitation from the Jo Daviess County Mayors Association to present at their September 2023 meeting. This association is moderated by Community Funding & Planning Services, which performs most of the grant writing for regional municipalities.

### NWILED STRATIGIC PLANNNING

As part of a renewed strategic planning exercise, the NWILED Board and Membership are considering convening fall 2023 for a visioning retreat to determine and set new organizational strategic goals. This exercise may include input from key NWILED stakeholders, including the Small Business Development Center at Sauk Valley Community College, Blackhawk Hills Regional Council, and Illinois Department of Commerce & Economic Opportunity.

### **NWILED STAFFING**

To enhance the scope of NWILED's outreach, the program coordinator position was backfilled June 2023. This role had been vacant since spring 2022. Expect a return of NWILED's 'Made in NW Illinois' business spotlight series!
