START - EXPAND - RELOCATE

Workforce Housing Study

Funding secured for 70 Daviess County

Blackhawk Hills Regional Council, a NWILED partner, will begin a workforce housing needs assessment study of Jo Daviess County beginning summer 2021. Housing is a perennial concern of public officials, major employers, and residents. The study will focus on availability, affordability, and the age of both the area's population and structures. Anticipated benefits include the generation of data usable by developers and local officials and the identification of how Covid-19 has impacted housing stock which will fuel future grant-writing opportunities, facilitate workforce growth and stabilization, give support to workers, and allow the region to keep pace with Iowa and Wisconsin investment.

This spring Emily Legel, NWILED Executive Director, worked with Jo Daviess County officials and municipalities to secure the county's necessary contribution of \$12,000 with Blackhawk Hills contributing an additional \$10,000 to fully fund the \$22,000 project which will take approximately nine months to complete. NWILED assisted the county with a \$2,500 contribution and will help facilitate the study locally in addition to moderating a steering committee of county stakeholders. Efforts to bring the study to Carroll County were not successful.

Riverport Railroad, LLC

Accessing the world through NW IL

Riverport Railroad (RVPR) is a Class III short line railroad serving a commercial, industrial, and distribution complex with 73 miles of track at the former Savanna Army Depot north of Savanna. Straddling both Carroll and Jo Daviess Counties, RVPR can store up to 2.900 railcars, is recognized as a BNSF Primer Transloader, and owns and or controls 1,995 acres. RVPR has been a NWILED member since 2014.

Community-based corporate citizenship is strongly promoted at RVPR. In 2020 they purchased and distributed Savanna Chamber of Commerce Bucks to local restaurants for Covid-19 quarantine promotions. RVPR donates to the United Way of NW IL Dolly Parton Imagination Library, area food pantries, Toys for Tots, and for the past seven years has awarded multiple \$2,000 trade scholarships to graduating seniors at River Ridge and West Carroll High Schools.

PASSENGER RAIL UPDATE

In June NWILED attended meeting #2 of the Rockford - Dubuque Passenger Rail Feasibility Study. Quandel Consultants updated steering committee members from across the region on the feedback generated at their May community focus group meetings, cooperation efforts with railroad companies, the status of station selection, and presented their initial field inspection reports from along proposed rail lines. July's update will focus on what service operations could look like.

SCHOLARSHIP UPDATE

Kaitlin Kilgore, a graduating senior from River Ridge High, was announced as the winner of the 2021 Build It Grow It Entrepreneurial Scholarship on May 20th receiving a \$1,000 cash prize. Kilgore is developing a hand-crafted artisan doll line and intends to use her prize money to complete a prototype doll. She will attend the Milwaukee Institute of Art & Design this fall. NWILED received a total of six applications this year. A judging panel selected this year's winner.

Round one of the Genz Memorial Investment Fund awards will be announced this summer. NWILED will fund three awards per year that range from \$4,000 to \$8,000 and will accept future applications on a rolling basis. Awards can be used for capital purchases, to purchase an existing business, or for startup and pilot projects.
